Re: Notice of Reinstatement of the Coastal Protection Fund Fee

Dear Taxpayer:

The General Land Office has certified that the Coastal Protection Fund has fallen below the minimum balance allowed by law. Therefore, by law, the Coastal Protection Fee has been reinstated effective June 1, 2024. Official notice will be published in the *Texas Register* on April 26, 2024. Crude oil transferred through a marine terminal on or after June 1, 2024, is subject to the 1.333 cents per barrel fee.

Your June return (Form 66-100) is due on July 31, 2024. Please note that you must file a return for each month even if no money is due. Collection of the Coastal Protection Fee will be suspended again if the fund reaches the maximum balance allowed by law. You will be notified if the fee is suspended.
